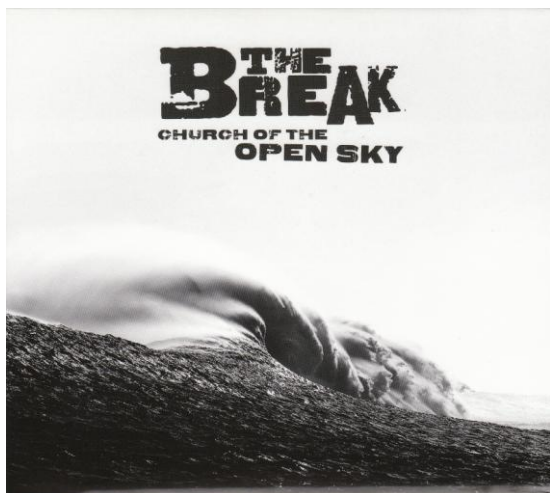

Album of the Year!!



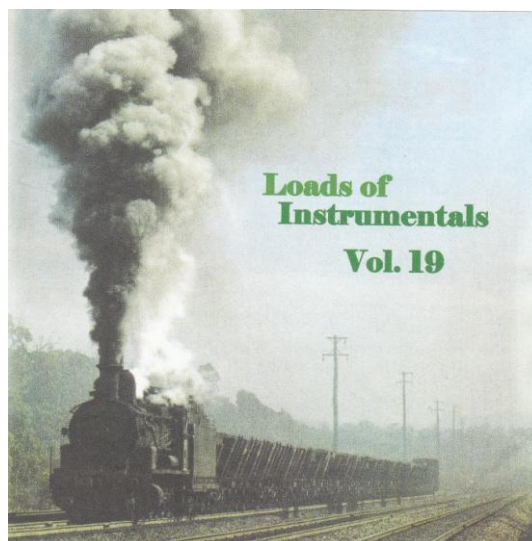

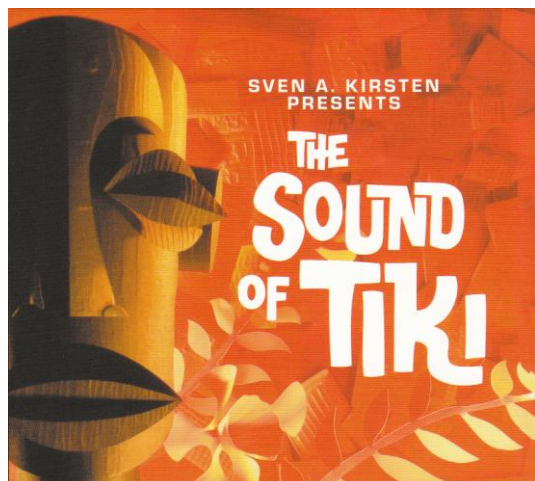

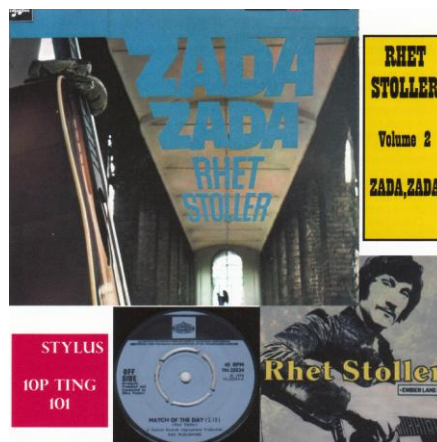

Jerry Cole was one of L.A.'s 'wrecking crew' and a prolific session guitarist.. In the early 60's he recorded a number of hot rod and surf albums under various names including the Hot Rodders, Blasters, Scramblers and the Stingers. This CD features tracks taken from two albums "Guitars A Go Go" Vols 1 & 2, recorded for the Crown label. Some great guitar sounds and techniques.

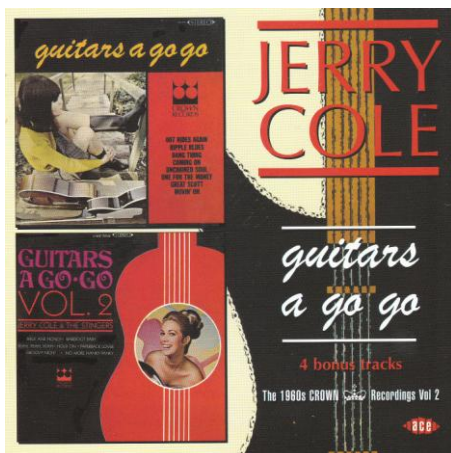
